Antal Lipthay was born in emigration in 1946 in the Netherlands. In 1949, with his parents, Baron Antal Lipthay (1923-2001) and Ilona born Velics de Lászlófalva (1923-2003), they emigrated to Chile. Since 1967 he has been working in advertising and communications at CLAVE Publicidad, CECOM, and ORBE Publicidad S.A. The last one serving mainly the public sector. He was Board member of Chile Films S.A., and the regional printed media network, SOPESUR S.A. He gave advice to the Government's Social Communications Directorate. In the 1980s he served as a diplomat in Vienna, Bonn and Bucharest as Chile's Cultural and Press Attaché. In 2021, the President of Hungary awarded him with the Knight's Cross of the Hungarian Order of Merit.
